Dear Members,

Re: Membership Renewals: Updates: Reminders re annual Forms: Renewal and Revoked Fee Offers:

Members are advised that we are giving them (and re-joining Members) the opportunity to upgrade any Horses who are in revoked status, i.e. Horses over 4years 6months who have not been upgraded to Permanent Adult **without having to pay the Revoked Fee.**
This offer is effective immediately and is in place until 31 July, 2018.

Further we are giving un-financial Members the opportunity to re-join in June and not pay the re-join fee and have their Membership carry through to 31 July, 2019. Under normal circumstances if an un-financial Member re-joins in June, they would only be entitled to Membership to 31 July, 2018. This will also assist Members who want to Lease or end a Lease, or do other transactions that require a person to be a Member.

As most Members are aware, Membership Renewals can now be done on line and paid by direct deposit into the MHAA® Bank Account via Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) and the Online Membership Renewal Form can then be emailed direct to the Registry office, to a dedicated email address, which has been set up to accept Membership Renewals.

For Membership Renewals on line, the process is quite simple:-

- (1) If paying via Direct Deposit to the MHAA® Bank Account, when making the deposit, ensure that you put your MHAA® Membership Number as the reference. When the payment transaction has been confirmed, complete Pages 1 and 2 of the Online Membership Renewal Form on line and make sure that you enter the bank receipt number in the box at the bottom of Page 2 and when completed, email the Online Membership Renewal Form to accounts@mhaa.com.au

KINDLY NOTE: IF THE BANK RECEIPT NUMBER IS NOT ON THE FORM, THE MEMBERSHIP/S WILL NOT BE ABLE TO BE PROCESSED.

If paying by other payment options, complete Pages 1 and 2 of the Membership Application / Membership Renewal Form and post with correct fees, to the Office, PO Box 454, Drouin, Victoria 3818.

For Members wishing to pay their Membership via cheque or credit card, we have enclosed a Membership Application / Renewal Form: for those Members who wish to pay via EFT, the online Membership Application / Renewal Form is available on the MHAA® website.

Reminder when Completing the Membership Application / Renewal Form on the website: it can be completed on line, but must be saved to your computer and then attached to an email. If not saved and sent straight from the online form you will be sending a blank form.

Following the success of the Membership Renewal Incentive which we have done for the last few years, we are again offering Members the opportunity of being involved. However this year we have included another incentive, i.e., if you renew your MHAA® Membership on or before the 1st August, 2018, your Membership number will go into a draw and the **first Member number drawn out will receive a FREE 2019 / 2020 Membership** (whatever category their Membership is). There will then be four more draws to receive your 2019 / 2020 Membership at half price.

Please note this applies to ALL Membership Renewals, irrespective if they are paid on line, or posted to the Office and to clarify in total there will be five Youth draws and five draws from a combination of Full, Joint, Family and Handler Memberships.

The above Members will be notified in the next day or so, regarding payment of their Memberships this year.

It is also timely to remind Members that in order to maintain continuity of their Membership, they must renew by the 1st August, 2018. If you have not renewed by that date, ALL Membership privileges will cease, i.e. you will not be able to Register Foals, Upgrade Horses, enter Shows, vote at State or National level, or lodge any relevant paperwork with the office. In addition to that you will not be able to nominate for, or hold a position on a State or National Committee, even if you currently hold that position, as you will have to stand down from the position and will not be able to nominate for a Committee position until after the next AGM.

Members are also reminded that if your Membership is not paid by the 1st of November, 2018, you will automatically be dropped from the Membership of the Association and re-joining after that date will incur a \$33-00 late fee, which will be enforced.

Therefore to maintain your financial Membership status: it is in your own best interest to renew your Membership by the 1st August, 2018.

As most Members are also aware, you can now make all payments to MHAA® Via EFT, by simply making your Payment to the MHAA® Bank Account, putting your Member Number as reference and complete the EFT Payment Form which is on the website.

Then prepare your paperwork in the normal manner and post to the office (we always recommend Express Post) with a copy of the EFT Payment Form.

This is going to alleviate hold-ups with paperwork due to incorrect credit card numbers, credit cards being declined etc and has been welcomed by many Members and is a definite move forward for the Association.

Stallion DNA: Sending your Stallion's DNA information to the office for noting on the MHAA® database:

We have been contacted by quite a few Members who are concerned about getting the DNA done for their Stallion and advising the MHAA® office before they send their Stallion Breeding Report (Stallion Return) into the office. There is no need for concern; there is no requirement to have your DNA lodged with the office until you want to register Foals..

You can send in your Stallion Returns as normal, to be received in the office, on or before 1 August, 2018 and if you have the DNA information for your Stallion, you can send it in at the same time. Otherwise as soon as you have the DNA information to send to the office, do so; that way when you want register your Foals you can do so without delay. This applies to all foal registration not just this season's Foals.

Mare DNA: Although these don't have to be lodged with the Association until the breeding season 2020 / 2021, many Members are already having their Mares DNA done. If you have already had yours done, then you can send to the office anytime to have this put on the MHAA® database. Don't forget if you want to have it noted on your Mare's Registration Certificate that her DNA is on file, you need to send the original Registration Certificate to the office at the same time.

REMINDERS: *It is also timely to remind Members that Stallion Breeding Reports (Stallion Returns) MUST be printed in LANDSCAPE format, NOT portrait format. Stallion Breeding Reports (Stallion Returns) submitted in portrait format will not be accepted and will be returned.* The Report can be filled in on line and then printed off in landscape to post to the office.

With regard to your **Stallion Breeding Reports (Stallion Returns):** always remember to include all outside Mares, as well as every Mare served, even if they are not registered MHAA® and remember to **keep a copy for your records.** Remember that a Tax Invoice/Receipt is always sent from the office on receipt of your Stallion Return. If you do not receive one within 21 days of posting your Return, contact the National Secretary or email the admin@mhaa.com.au, to make sure it has been received.

Stallion Returns may be sent to the office at any time and we recommend that as soon as you have finished mating your Mares, send the Stallion Breeding Report (Stallion Return) to the office.

Mare Nominations for Foal Futurity entries: If you have never nominated your Mare, you should consider doing so. If your Mare has been nominated, then you should consider entering her progeny in the Foal Futurity Classes at the 2019 National Show. So, get those Mare Nominations in ... remember the closing date for Mare Nominations is 1 August, 2018.

These nominations are for the National Foal Futurities, however some States run their own Foal Futurities and so you should check your State Website, or contact your State Representative to see if they hold a Foal Futurity event. National and State Futurities are run completely separately.

For those who do not understand the purpose of nominating your Mare or entering the National Foal Futurities, these are explained hereunder.

Mare nomination fees of \$11 received each year, are divided by 5 and that money is allocated to each year the foal is eligible to show i.e. Foal, Yearling, 2 year old, 3 year old, 4 year old. Those funds, along with the entry fees for all Horses entered in the relevant Foal Futurity Class are added up and from that money, Trophies and Ribbons costs, together with a percentage of the expenses of the particular Show are deducted and the balance is paid out to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd winners. Once a horse is over four years old, it is no longer eligible for futurity classes.

It is the Member's responsibility to make sure that your horse is eligible for the Futurity Class you enter, as there are no refunds on entry fees as all monies are paid to the winners. Members should also keep a copy of all Mare Nomination Forms that they send to the office, so they can check to make sure that the Mare has in fact been nominated, before they enter their Horse in the Foal Futurity Class. To assist Members in this regard, ALL Mares nominated (listed in the years they were nominated) are now on the MHAA® website, under the National Show section.

Mare Nomination Forms are on the website and for those Members who nominate several Mares; to assist Members, we have a new Form which enables you to enter up to 14 Mares on the one form.

If you wish to have the Mare Nominations / Foal Futurities explained further please contact the National Secretary.

MHAA® Website: We have from time to time, due to the server, been experiencing problems with the website and apologise if you have been inconvenienced in this regard. If you do notice a problem, please let us know, so that we can get it rectified immediately, as if no one tells us we are unaware of the problem.

Members are also reminded that it is recommended that they send mail to the Registry Office by Express Mail and also make sure that when they post mail that they allow for time delays, which seem to be more frequent with the mail these days.

DON'T FORGET THAT ALL Registrations and Membership Renewals are to be sent to the Registry Office, PO Box 454, Drouin, Victoria 3818, which is also noted on all Forms.

Changes of address or email: Please remember if you change your postal or email address, you need to notify the office by using the change of address form, which is on the website.

Please note that when you send in your Membership Renewal Form and your details have changed from those in the data base; these will automatically be updated.
