STALLION BREEDING REPORT (STALLION RETURN) - DUE FOR LODGEMENT BY 1st AUGUST ANNUALLY:

In order for the Association to build an accurate Stud Book, all individual Members must also keep accurate records. These records begin with the Stallion Breeding Report (Stallion Return) which must be lodged with the Association at the end of every breeding season; however most studs would be in a position to lodge a return once the breeding program is completed. All Stallion Breeding Reports must be submitted by August 1st of each year, however if a breeding Stallion dies during any current breeding year, his Stallion report is due within thirty days following his death.

PLEASE BE SURE TO CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING WHEN LODGING A STALLION RETURN:

- 1) If you serve a mare with two stallions, unless there is a minimum of 42 days between the services by each, you may be required to carry out DNA testing to establish the parentage.
- 2) If you have sold your Stallion since breeding him to some of your mares, you must still lodge a stallion return if you wish to register his foals.
- 3) Small Horse category Mares and Stallions must also be included on the Stallion Breeding Report (Stallion Return).

COMPLETING A STALLION BREEDING REPORT

- 1) Submit a separate report on each Stallion each year (including deceased stallions within thirty days of their death). Be sure to fill in the FULL REGISTERED NAME of the Stallion as it appears on the Registration Certificate and the CORRECT REGISTRATION NUMBER. If the name and number are incorrect, it causes delays in entering the information into the computer and the possibility that the subsequent foal will not be able to be registered.
- 2) The Stallion Breeding Report (Stallion Return) must be post marked no later than 31st July of the year following the breeding season.
 - a) On or before the 31st July each year, the owner of every Stallion must submit a written report showing the names and registration numbers of all Mares put to the Stallion. Be sure to fill in the FULL REGISTERED NAMES of the Mares and the CORRECT REGISTRATION NUMBERS. The name must be as it appears on the Registration Certificate. PLEASE NO NICKNAMES.
 - b) The Stallion Breeding Report (Stallion Return) shall also include all hand breeding dates, artificial insemination dates, or dates the Mare was running with the Stallion (paddock served).
 - c) This report shall include all Mares served, whether owned by the owner of the Stallion or owned by other parties.
- 3) The owner of the Stallion will require a copy of the Mares Registration Certificate in order to facilitate the completion of this form.
- 4) Give exact date(s) the Mare was exposed to the Stallion. If more than one service is given to a Mare be sure to show the different dates.
- 5) If paddock served, give date the Mare was turned into the paddock and the date the Mare was taken out of the paddock.
- 6) If hand bred or artificially inseminated, state the exact day(s).
- 7) Always **PRINT CLEARLY IN BLOCK LETTERS** to ensure the correct details are recorded.
- 8) Make sure when printing that it is in LANDSCAPE and NOT PORTRAIT

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT THE BREEDING DATES BE CORRECT AND PRECISE

SUBMITTING STALLION BREEDING REPORTS (STALLION RETURNS)

If submitted by 1 August: If you have not received a tax receipt as acknowledgement of receipt of your Stallion Breeding Report (Stallion Return) from the office within 21 days of posting, the onus is on you, the member, to contact MHAA either by email ... admin@mhaa.com.au or the Registrar.

If not submitted: If a Stallion Breeding Report (Stallion Return) has not been submitted within the time frame set out in the Constitution, independent proof of parentage is required (DNA) before the foal can be recorded on a Registration Certificate, otherwise the foal cannot be registered until it is two years old and the Registration Certificate will show parentage as 'Unknown'.

REMINDERS:

INCLUDE ALL OUTSIDE MARES ON YOUR STALLION BREEDING REPORT (STALLION RETURN).

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT MEMBERS KEEP A COPY OF THE STALLION BREEDING REPORT (STALLION RETURN) FOR THEIR OWN RECORDS.

IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED YOUR TAX RECEIPT ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE STALLION BREEDING REPORT (STALLION RETURN) WITHIN 21 DAYS OF POSTING IT, PLEASE CONTACT MHAA, EITHER BY EMAIL ... admin@mhaa.com.au OR THE REGISTRAR.
