CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All Horses must be measured before being shown, unless they have an MHAA® Permanent Height Card

Measuring times: To be confirmed when entries closed.

- 2. All Horses must be branded or micro-chipped and will have brands / microchips checked at measuring. Please ensure that the brands are visible.
- 3. Height for age and exhibit age is taken from 1st of August.
- 4. All Horses **must** have a current MHAA® registration.
- 5. There is no 6 month leeway for show horses, upgrades **must** be updated.
- 6. A colour copy of Registration papers & Membership Card must be sent with your entries and must be carried with you at the Show.
- 7. All protests must be lodged in writing, within 15 minutes of the completion of the class, along with a \$75-00 fee (non-refundable if not upheld)
- 8. Foals less than 4 months of age must be accompanied by their Dam and be halter trained.
- 9. All entrants must be financial Members of MHAA®.
- 10. All Horses must be entered by the owner/lessee of the Horse.
- 11. Ages of Handlers will be as at the 1st August.
- 12. All competitors must remain in the ring until dismissed by Judge or Steward.
- 13. It is the Member's responsibility to make sure they are at the ring gate in time for their Class. If your horse has changed Class due to measurement, make sure you attend the correct class.
- 14. It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to keep their float area clean and tidy, all manure, hay and rubbish must be removed.
- 15. **Harness Classes:** MHAA® are based on the Australian Carriage Driving Society Inc (ACDS) regulations; for further clarification check their website: www.acds.org.au It is a Member's responsibility to check these Rules.

Horses 3 years & over are eligible to enter Harness Classes.

Youth Drivers must wear Helmets.

The wearing of an approved Helmet is required.

A competent Adult SHOULD accompany Youth Drivers and MUST accompany Youth Drivers under 12 years.

It is recommended for Headers to be in the line-up.

Headers must be MHAA® Members and wear show attire.

All Horses must have winkers on the bridle.

Head-checks are NOT permitted.

The "New-Comer Harness Class" is for Horses or Drivers who are just starting out in Harness and will be a basic work out. Competitors who enter this Class are able to enter all other Harness Classes.

16. Guidelines for Turnout Class:

Judged on the whole turnout: the Horse, vehicle, harness and overall general appearance. Cleanliness, quality of turnout, correct fit of harness and vehicle, the Horse's performance and the dress and accessories of the driver are judged.

- 17. Amateur Owner / Handler with Novice Horse that has not won a National Supreme: (AONH): The exhibitor MUST own the Horse. The exhibitor MUST be an amateur, i.e., a person who has never received monetary payment or goods in kind for training or showing Horses for other people. The Horse MUST be a Novice Horse that has never won a National Supreme.
- 18. **Amateur Owned & Exhibited (AOE):** The exhibitor MUST own the Horse. The exhibitor MUST be an amateur, i.e., a person who has never received monetary payment or goods in kind for training or showing Horses for other people.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: (Contd.,)

19. WAIVERS

It is now a Condition of Entry that Members complete and sign the Waiver, which has been included with the 2024 / 2025 MHAA® Victorian State Show information and this MUST be returned with Show entries.

Any Competitor who has not competed and signed the Waiver Forms and returned with their entries, will not be permitted to Show.

- 20. We reserve the right to combine or split Classes, throughout the Show Schedule, should the need arise. If this becomes necessary, Members affected will be advised.
- 21. All competitors must abide by the MHAA® Constitution, Show Rules and General Rules & Regulations Please refer to the MHAA® website, where they are all available.
- 22. On completing and signing the Entry Form, it is accepted that you have agreed to all the Conditions of Entry that apply to this Show and will abide by them.
- 23. In addition to the MHAA® Conditions of Entry, all Elmore Equestrian Park Conditions of Entry apply.

Elmore Horse Facility Fee: As those of you who have shown at Elmore Equestrian previously are aware there is compulsory Horse Facility Fee of \$9.00 per day per Miniature Equine. However, we have been able to negotiate this with the Venue Management to a lower fee for Members who are showing for the 3 days and NMR have kindly subsidized this further, so that Members who show on Friday and Saturday with NMR and on Sunday with MHAA®, they only have to pay \$16.00 per Miniature Equine for the 3 days. Therefore, as we have to pay the horse facility fee to the venue after the event, we suggest that if you are showing with NMR and MHAA® that you pay the Horse Facility Fee of \$16.00 per Miniature Equine for the 3 days, to NMR with your entries. High Point MHAA® Miniature Horse & High Point MHAA® Small Horse Of Show

For this Show, every Class (excepting Fancy Dress, Long-Reign and Harness), that your Horse enters, it will be eligible to attract points if it places 1st, 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} . Champions & Reserves will be counted, but Supremes will not be.

These Points will be: 3 points for 1st place, 2 points for 2nd place and 1 point for 3rd place; Champion 2 points, Reserve 1 point, irrespective of how many in the Class.

Therefore, every Class (excepting Fancy Dress, Long-Reign and Harness) you have entered your Horse in, even Best Presented, Colour, Classic Trot, Vic Bred etc, you will automatically have the chance to accrue points towards the Overall Miniature High Point Horse of Show and Overall High Point Small Horse of the Show.

Kindly note: to qualify for these High Point awards, you MUST enter the relevant Breed Class PLUS 4 other Classes, but noting not including Fancy Dress, Long-Reign and Harness.

There will be a Sash and prize awarded for the High Point Miniature and Small Horse of the Show.
